Since then, he has done freelance illustration for various publications, including “The New York Times”, “The Village Voice”, and “Avenue” magazine. He started his fine art career in 1996 when he founded the “4E Gallery” in Tribeca where he showed various artists, as well as his own work every month.

He also showed at numerous galleries and clubs, including the “Ace Gallery”, the “Gershwin Gallery”, “The Tunnel” and “Faces and Names”, (159 W. 54th St.), and “Rumours” (8th Ave. & 55th St.) where he has a permanent exhibitions. He has also done live caricatures at “Faces and Names” since they opened in 1997.
